Sir (or Madam):-

You are hereby authorized and directed to proceed, on official business, on or about April 15, 1935, to New Mexico, Arizona, Colorado, Utah, Nevada, California and Texas, for the purpose of investigations in connection with registration statements.

You will be allowed per diem in lieu of actual expenses for subsistence, together with actual and necessary traveling expenses, subject to the limitations prescribed by law and regulations, when absent on official business from your designated post of duty as shown in sections A & B and C, as specified below:

- (A) Necessary transportation by common carrier or public conveyance, whenever practicable and economical.
- (B) Use of own automobile at five cents per mile, when it is shown that such mileage is more economical and advantageous to the United States, computed by actual meter readings from and returning to the city limits of your official station.
- (C) Subsistence at \$5 per diem in lieu of actual subsistence expenses, but no subsistence is allowed where entire absence takes place between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Upon completion of this assignment you will return to your post of duty at Phoenix, Arizona.
