Mr. Arthur Deane telephoned from Los Angeles last night (can be reached c/o Southern California Edison Company, Michigan 7121). He intended to bring personally the \$73,000,000 registration papers for filing this week, but will be unable to do so and is sending a messenger by plane Friday. The plane is due at 5:00 PM Saturday. Can we keep the necessary force on after 5:00 PM Saturday and Sunday, if necessary, in order that filing may be made at once? Mr. McKellar had wired him that we would keep someone on until 5:00, as he questioned the legality of filing after that hour or on Sunday. Mr. Throop could not settle this point. I promised Mr. Deane that his request would be met unless the question of legality prevented it, and that we would wire him the first thing this morning.

Also, Mr. Deane asked that forty-eight hours notice be given him in the event his presence is needed here after the papers had been examined, etc.
