I have your letter of December 23 in which you advise that the Treasury Department will in compliance with my request issue directions to the Superintendent of the Mint at Denver, authorizing him to make available to the Regional Administrator of this Commission at Denver information regarding the quantities of shipments to the Denver Mint by specified vendors and the amount of payment by the Denver Mint for such shipments.
