SUBJECT:

I have just talked to Mr. David Sarnoff, Chairman of the Radio Corporation of America, about Jack Yandell. After listening to the story Mr. Sarnoff made the following statement to me:

"I will advise Jack by all means to take this opportunity of helping the Government and Joe Kennedy. I will hold his job open for him until he returns, and I will agree to pay the difference between such salary as the Government pays him and that which he is paid by the Radio Corporation - the latter I will do out of my own pocket."

He added further the request that we convey to Joe his desire to help him in any way possible in the important job which he has undertaken. I am now trying to get Yandell on the telephone to find out whether or not he is well enough to take the job.
