Dear Mr. Chester:

On June 21, 1954, you were informed that since another employee has declined to transfer to the position of Securities Investigator, GS-11, Seattle Regional Office, it had been determined that you could be offered on a tentative basis the opportunity to transfer to that position at your present salary, \$6,940 per annum.

It has now definitely been determined to transfer you to the position of Securities Investigator, GS-11, \$6,940 per annum, Seattle Regional Office. This administrative reassignment is in lieu of the termination of your services by reduction in force as was proposed in the notification issued to you on June 1, 1954. Accordingly, that notice is hereby cancelled.

In order to allow sufficient time to work out the necessary arrangements incident to your transfer to the Seattle Regional Office, while your last work day in your present position will be July 2, 1954, you will be carried in an annual leave status thereafter through the close of business July 23, 1954.

Official authorization for your transfer to the Seattle Regional Office and payment for the transportation and other expenses incident thereto is contained in the attached letter. You will note that you are to report to your new duty station on August 2, 1954.
