Dear Neal:

Enclosed is a letter from the NASD which proposes a seemingly very sensible simplification of the list of margin eligible stocks. Instead of developing a list <u>de novo</u>, with long delays between issuances, the Fed could simply incorporate all NASDAQ eligible stocks by reference, as are all listed stocks today. The Fed could, obviously, periodically publish a list of additional margin eligible stocks.

I would appreciate it if you could have someone review this proposal and give me a 1-2 page memo setting forth its pros and cons. This system could be simple, easy to apply and updated daily, which are significant advantages.
