Upon the application of the United States of America, by Rudolph W. Giuliani, United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, John K. Carroll, Assistant United States Attorney, of counsel, and upon a review of both the defendant's and the Government's proposed redacted and unredacted sentencing memoranda, it is hereby found:

that the unredacted memoranda contains factual statements relevant to the Court's imposition of sentence, the public release of which both would unfairly disclose the identities of the subjects of pending Government and grand jury investigations and would compromise those investigations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the unredacted sentencing memoranda of the United States and of the defendant shall be filed under seal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such memoranda, as they are included in the defendant's presentence report, be filed and maintained under seal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the redacted sentencing memoranda of the United States and of the defendant shall be filed on the date of sentencing as in the normal course.
