As you may know, it has been announced that Jake Stillman will become the Commission's Solicitor on January 1, 1999. I am also pleased to announce that Eric Summergrad will become Deputy Solicitor at the same time. Like Jake, he is a superb legal craftsman and appellate lawyer, and I am delighted that he will be serving in this new position.

Eric joined the Commission in 1984 as a Special Counsel in the Appellate Group, and has risen through various positions in the Group, most recently serving since 1992 as Principal Assistant General Counsel. Prior to coming to the Commission, Eric was associated with the law firm of Arnold & Porter. He graduated from Oberlin College and received his J.D. degree from New York University Law School, where he was an editor of the New York University Law Review.
